GRANDE VOITURE du CALIFORNIA NURSES TRAINING GUIDELINES

NURSES TRAINING: Per Grand Directeur Jack Schipper

Income is derived from the sale of National Nurses Training Pins that are issued to Locales on consignment. All money is turned over to the Grand Commissaire Intendant who in turn forwards the cost of Pins annually to the National Directeur of Nurses Training. The balance is retained in the CA Nurses Training Fund, known as the Harry C Stanly Memorial Nurses Training Scholarship Fund. Other donations are sometimes received to the Fund.

The Harry C Stanley Memorial Nurses Training Scholarship Fund, STANLEY FUND, is available to Voitures Locale to assist in their Nurses Training Scholarships. The amount available varies annually with the sale of pins. At no time can the balance in the trust fall below \$20,000.00, in other words, pin sales and interest sustain the fund. Applications must be received by the Grand Directeur 60 days prior to Grande Promenade, and the delegates approve disbursement. No scholarship awards will be presented to any Voiture Locale that does not participate in the program through the purchase of the annual Nurses Training Pins.
