Income is derived from the sale of POW pins that are issued to Locales on consignment. All money is turned over to the Grand Commissaire Intendant who in turn forwards the money annually to the National POW Scholarship Fund, less \$700 to pay for the following year's pins.

The National POW/MIA Scholarship Fund for survivors of POW/MIA's is administered by the trustees of the fund, is generally limited to \$500.00 per year for 4 years, and requires evidence of the following eligibility:

1. Verifiable documentation of relationship to the Veteran thru which the application is being made,
2. Certified transcripts of the previous academic achievements,
3. Financial need,
4. Written acceptance of enrollment by an accredited college or university, and
5. Continuing academic achievement of not less than grade "C" average.

All scholarship funds will be paid directly to the college or university. Applications and further information is available on the National Web Site, www.fortyandeight.org Programs, POW/MIA. The Annual Reporting Form is available on the Resources/Petit Communiqué tab.

The Grand Directeur will submit a current Pin Accounting Form to the Grand Correspondant at each Grande Voiture Meeting (Grandes Cheminots & Grande Promenade) . The form will be provided by the Grand Correspondant and is listed on the Grande Voiture Web Site www.cafortyandeight.org
